The HSE published figures which states that around **8,000** people each year in the UK alone lose their life due to cancer caused by inhaling hazardous dust particles at work. 
Let's put that number into perspective: in the UK in 2023, 1,633 people were killed in road traffic accidents.

What is the Importance?

Dust is a silent killer, and over exposure can have a number of harmful effects on health, including:

- <u>Respiratory problems</u>: Dust can irritate the lungs and airways, leading to respiratory problems such as asthma, bronchitis, and pneumonia.
- <u>Skin problems</u>: Dust can irritate the skin, causing rashes, dermatitis, and other skin conditions.
- <u>Eye problems</u>: Dust can get into the eyes, causing irritation, redness, and inflammation.
- <u>Cancer</u>: Some types of dust can be carcinogenic, meaning that they can cause cancer.







What is an M-Class Vacuum?

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M-class dust extraction helps to protect workers from the harmful effects of dust by capturing the smallest dust particles. This helps to keep the air clean and safe to breathe.

Suitable for light or medium Hazard applications, an M-Class Industrial Vacuum Cleaner is a vacuum cleaner that has been designed to limit the risk of exposure to the operator of potentially harmful dusts which over time may present a risk of occupational disease.

The filtration system needs to capture at least **99.9%** of dust.

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It's the Law!

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An M-Class vacuum is the legal minimum requirement advised by the HSE for vacuuming 'medium risk' hazardous dusts and is legally binding under COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health).

It's the law to use no less than an M-Class Vacuum on any construction site. The consequences of being found guilty of health and safety errors can include imprisonment in the most serious cases, as well as disqualification as a company director for up to 15 years. HSE fines of up to £20,000 are common, and in cases of serious negligence they can be unlimited.

Education is key to highlight the importance to health as well as the laws and legislations required.



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HEPA 14 vs HEPA 13

The main difference between HEPA 13 and HEPA 14 filters lies in their efficiency levels. HEPA 13 filters capture at least 99.95% of particles that are 0.3 microns or larger, while HEPA 14 filters capture at least 99.995% of such particles. This indicates that HEPA 14 filters are more efficient than HEPA 13 filters.

Another distinction is their intended usage. HEPA 13 filters are commonly found in residential and commercial air purifiers, vacuum cleaners, and HVAC systems. In contrast, HEPA 14 filters are typically used in specialized environments such as cleanrooms, hospitals, and laboratories where extremely clean air is required.



"Not as good as I expected. Tool accessories are left inside the casing, so you have to take off the top and pull out the bag to get to them. In other manufacturers' designs, the tool accessories sit on the outside Also, the tube where it meets the bag blocks very easily. This is due to a slightly angled plastic guard to point the tube into the bag. Most hoovers of this type have a straight connection into the bag. So as a tradesman, who has to hoover everything from dust to small bits of rubble and debris, the small bits of rubble/debris will prove a problem. All in all, I've moved away from the Screwfix hoover, because they stopped selling the bags. **Should have bought a Henry** Hoover."
